SFA vice-President Tauii'ili Frank Cordtz accepted the cheque on behalf of the association.

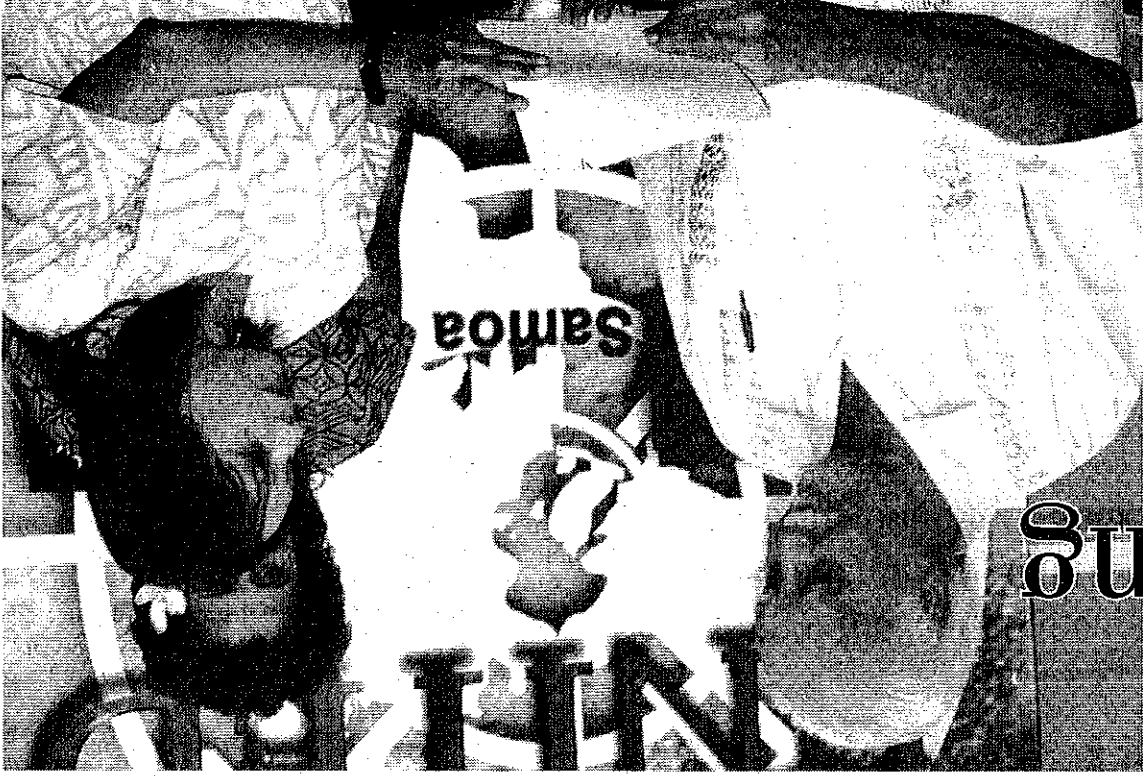
UN Resident Coordinator to Samoa Naheed Haque in an address to SFA, said
